



MILITARY CAPACITY (rank)






Strong economies ranking

ECONOMY (rank)









Political influence ranking

POLITICAL INFLUENCE (rank)






Media/Communication influence ranking

CULTURAL ATTRACTIVENESS (point)



Assumption on Top Investors into Vietnam


TOP INVESTORS INTO VIETNAM (rank)






Political Influence on Vietnam's Government

Conclusion

- The U.S. definitely confirms its leadership in every area of today's world.
- America is almost certainly a superpower as nearly half of respondents preferred an American world policeman.
- Appearance of China after the U.S. is considerably noteworthy.
- They do not refute a powerful America but they always compare it with China.



Conclusion (cont.)

- America will find it difficult on account of major competitors such as EU, China, India, Japan.
- America is not as strong enough as it used to be. China will soon defeat America to become the premier country. America will "share the world" with China.
- America possesses many advantages. They expect a benevolent America to cooperate with others using its strength to maintain a stable world in which Vietnam will be one of beneficiaries.
