

#### **Brief History Timeline**

1889-1946: INDOCHINA: FRENCH POSSESSION ON THE CAMBODIAN PENINSULA IN SOUTHEAST ASIA
BORDERING ON THE SOUTH CHINA SEA AND GULF OF SIAM. WAS A FRENCH COLONY AND PROTECTORATE.
CAPITAL HANOI

1940-45: JAPANESE OCCUPATION BUT FRENCH ALLOWED TO RUN COUNTRY

1945: EMPEROR BAO DAI PROCLAIMED INDEPENDENCE WICH INCLUDED PROPECTORATES OF TONKIN, ANNAM AND COCHIN-CHINA. HE ABDICATED TO VIET MINH

1946-46: VIET MINH OVERPRINTS OF FRENCH INDOCHINA STAMPS. COMMUNIST PARTISANS FIGHTING THE JAPANESE IN WWII AND FRENCH 1945-54. DIRECTED BY HO CHI MINH FROM JUNGLES

1947-49: FRENCH & HO GOVERNMENT

1949: ASSOCIATED STATE FRENCH UNION

1951-54: BOA DAI EMPEROR UNDER FRENCH CONTROL

1954: COMMUNIST VIET MINH TOOK CONTROL OF NORTH VIETNAM WITH CAPITAL IN HANOI. FRENCH ARE DEFEATED AT DIEN BIEN PHU

1955: REPUBLIC SOUTH VIETNAM ESTABLISHED PRES, NGO DINH DIEM WITH CAPITOL IN SAIGON

1958-75: NATIONAL LIBERATION FRONT AKA VIET CONG

1975: SOUTH & NORTH UNIFIED WITH CAPITAL IN HANOI
